Leadership Training: Physical Literacy and Value-based Approach

The European Sport YMCA (ESY) is carrying out a leadership development project for young people within sport, and **you** are invited to apply to participate!



The project is called "Physical Literacy and Value-based Approach" and it will run from July to September 2021. Participants must be able to:

- attend the seminar in Denmark from July 4-10, including travel days
- attend the seminar in Italy from September 8-12, including travel days
- implement a mini-project in their home country between the two seminars.

The leadership training is open to voluntary youth leaders with a minimum of three years of leadership experience, preferably within the YMCA (KFUM).

The project will develop participants' skills in establishing sport projects and events for children and youth through methods such as value-based leadership and physical literacy (active lifestyle). The teaching style is informal, participatory and fun, and participants will be part of an international group of 25 young leaders from seven European countries.

The project is financed by the EU (Erasmus+) and there are three free spots for participants from Sweden. This means that, if you apply and are accepted to be part of the Swedish delegation, you will only contribute with your time and commitment.
